

Code of Conduct

Alcohol Policy

LGSMUN and Lahore Grammar School's administration will not tolerate the possession or consumption of alcohol on campus or at the event under any circumstance. Any delegate found to have consumed alcohol before or during the event will be immediately disqualified from the conference, along with their delegation/associated group. Disqualification entails being ineligible for any and all awards, and being barred from entering campus grounds. Delegates will also be subjected to legal questioning.

Drugs and Controlled Substances Policy

Any misuse or abuse of drugs and controlled substances discovered by the Executive Council will result in the immediate disqualification of the concerned delegate from the conference. The delegate will be barred from entering campus grounds, and delegation points will be automatically deducted.

Hotel Courtesy

Lahore Grammar School Defence will not be held responsible for any vandalism, damage, excessive noise, inappropriate behaviour, false fire alarms, access to unauthorized areas and/or any other inappropriate behaviour within the hotel in which delegates are staying. Delegates, Faculty Advisors, and Chaperones will be responsible for their own behaviour off campus. Hotel management reserves the right to remove or expel any guest disturbing the overall wellbeing and maintenance of their premises and guests.

Valuables

Lahore Grammar School Defence is not responsible for the loss of any valuable items. Delegates are strongly advised to keep their valuables with them at all times, and to leave them in their hotel rooms/safe deposit boxes at their own risk.

Expulsion From The Conference

The Executive Council possesses the authority to expel any Delegate, delegation, school, or group from the conference at any time for failing to comply with conference regulations and our code of conduct. Expulsions will commence with immediate effect upon their issuance, and all relevant conference materials, such as delegate tags and placards will be confiscated.

Conference Tags

Delegates are cautioned to keep their delegate tags issued by LGSMUN with them at all times. Any delegate who has lost his/her tag must immediately report the matter to their committee chairs, upon which a new tag will be issued to the delegate once his/her registration has been confirmed. The possession of a tag is necessary for entering and exiting the conference venue. Delegates can be asked to produce their tags at any given moment during the conference.

Dress Code

Delegates are requested to comply with the a formal dress code; western formal business attire is preferred.

Photography and Video

LGSMUN and its media team has reserved the right to photograph and record videos of participants throughout the duration of the conference. The acquired material may be used for publications, the web page or for promotional purposes. Signing the waiver of liability means that delegates have consented to this policy.

Interpretation of Rules

All determinations of outcomes pertaining to the code of conduct and its violation are in the hands of the Executive Council.
